

Yuin Walbunga Aboriginal Cultural Tour of the Eurobodalla

Provided by Vikki Parsley our qualified Aboriginal guide, the Yuin Walbunga Cultural Tour will immerse you in Australian Aboriginal life while you learn about this pristine estuary environment. Sample bush tucker foods, try traditional fibre weaving and explore sites for wildlife, ochre and artefacts. Groups limited to five enjoy luxury transport and refreshments.

Each of the following tour zones are a half day tour (4 hours) & includes a traditional Welcome to Yuin Walbunga Country & Cleansing Ceremony plus a midpoint stop for light refreshments.

A full day tour (7 hours) will cover all three zones & includes morning tea and picnic lunch.

Northern Aboriginal Heritage Tour - starting in the Batemans Bay area

Travel to unspoilt Depot Beach for an interpretive talk about Aboriginal life while photographing native wildlife and flora up close.

Take a wetland walking tour to learn about this pristine estuary environment & traditional food gathering methods.

Explore Barlings Beach in search of middens, sources of ochre & Aboriginal fishing artefacts

Take an easy exploration walk at Melville Point Lookout, Broulee Beach, & the Canoe Tree.

Central Aboriginal Heritage Tour - starting in the Broulee / Moruya area

Travel to the village of Congo to examine ancient middens & naturally occurring sources of stone tools & ochre for painting & dyeing.

Travel to Bingie for morning tea of damper & bush tucker preserves while being shown traditional artefacts & fibre weaving. Listen to the story of Gulaga & her sons Najanuga & Barunguba.

Travel to Blackfellows Point via historic Bodalla & Potato Point to see kangaroos & sea eagles up close while exploring middens & food gathering areas on the Tuross River.

Stop & see the breathtaking granite monoliths at Whittakers Creek while listening to the story of the two Jeringa women turn to stone. Learn about mullet spearing & netting in the creek.

Drive via forest bush trails to traditional hunting sites around Narooma.

Southern Aboriginal Heritage Tour - starting in the Narooma area

Travel to Mummaga Lake, Lawlers Creek & Kianga to examine traditional fishing areas, middens, food & ochre gathering locations.

Take in the aqua marine colours of Wagonga Inlet from Australia Rock lookout & explore Nangudga Lake, Hankerchief Beach & Mystery Bay in search of middens & traditional food & ochre gathering areas.

Travel to heritage listed village of Tilba Tilba & listen to the story of Gulaga & her sons Najanuga & Barunguba before returning to Narooma via forest trails and the foothills of Gulaga (Mt Dromedary).
